Colonel Johnny R. McGonigal is the Director, Air Force Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps, Maxwell Air Force Base, Alabama. He is responsible for the Air Force's high school citizenship training program comprised of about 125,000 students and 1,900 instructors at approximately 880 high schools worldwide. Colonel McGonigal directs staff initiatives and policy to implement the world's largest and most comprehensive aerospace science education program.

Colonel McGonigal is a 1998 graduate of Missouri State University and was commissioned through Officer Training School, Maxwell AFB, Alabama in 2000. He first entered the Air Force in 1989 as an Air Traffic Control Apprentice. His career includes various operational Theater Air Control System assignments as an instructor senior director, air weapons officer, mission crew commander, and director of operations. He commanded the 729th Air Control Squadron, Hill AFB Utah.

Colonel McGonigal is a master air battle manager with over 2200 hours in the E-3 Sentry Airborne Warning and Control System aircraft including over 500 combat hours and 150 combat support hours.
