Chief Master Sergeant Jason L. Hodges is the Commandant, Air Force First Sergeant Academy, Ira C. Eaker Center for Leadership Development, Maxwell-Gunter Air Force Base, Alabama. In this role, he serves as the principal advisor to the Chief Master Sergeant of the Air Force, the First Sergeant Special Duty Manager, and the Ira C. Eaker Center for Leadership Development on the development, education, and training of over 700 newly selected first sergeants per year. The Air Force First Sergeant Academy administers a demanding course focused on preparing active duty, guard, and reserve first sergeants to be key advisors to commanders on the readiness, health, morale, and welfare of Airmen and families across the Air Force. Chief Hodges is the 19th Chief Master Sergeant to serve in this position.

Chief Hodges entered the Air Force in March 1994. His background includes various duties in logistics readiness. Throughout his career he has also served as a Convoy Commander, Combat Instructor, Curriculum Developer, Mediator, Senior Enlisted Leader, First Sergeant and First Sergeant MAJCOM Functional Manager. Chief Hodges has deployed in support of numerous contingencies and joint



tours, including OPERATIONS SOUTHERN WATCH, JOINT GUARD, TASK FORCE DANGER, IRAQI FREEDOM, NEW DAWN, ENDURING FREEDOM, FREEDOM SENTINEL and INHERENT RESOLVE. Prior to his current position, Chief Hodges was the Command Chief, 509th Bomb Wing, Whiteman Air Force Base, Missouri.
