SMSgt Jarvis M. Wilson serves as the Senior Enlisted Leader, Squadron Officer School, Air University, Maxwell Air Force Base, Alabama. Every year, the School educates over 4,200 Department of the Air Force captains, civilians, and international military officers to think, communicate, cooperate, and lead in the joint environment. The school's team of military and civilian faculty develop and teach Professional Military Education curricula that begins with the students' preparation to serve as senior Air Force leaders.

Prior to this assignment, SMSgt Wilson was assigned as the Senior Enlisted Leader, 1st Special Operations Contracting Squadron, Hurlburt Field, Florida serving as the principal advisor to the Commander on all manpower selection, staffing, resource allocation, training, and personnel issues. The Contracting Squadron was responsible for managing and executing a contract portfolio of \$282 million while providing acquisition support to 4 wings, 25 squadrons, and 46 tenant units across the Air Force's #1 deployed and most lethal wing.

Sergeant Wilson enlisted in the Air Force in June 2006 and graduated Contracting Apprentice Technical School in October 2006. He has served in multiple Contracting support roles including management, administration, award and termination of construction, services, and commodities contracts. Sergeant Wilson has deployed three times in support of OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM and OPERATION INHERENT RESOLVE.
